

A special meeting of the Beverly Town Council was held Monday, August 19, 2019, at 6:30 pm in council chambers of the Beverly Town Hall. Members present were Mayor Andy Burns, recorder Barbara Smith, council members Debbie Stalnaker, Robbie Moyers, Matt Lewis, Becky Weese and Katie Whittaker. Visitors included Kenny Weese.

Town attorney, Rob Chenoweth, pulled the town charter and reviewed the latest rule, #3:21. He informed the clerk that all ordinances must have three readings.

An Ordinance of The Town of Beverly Establishing the Beverly Building Commission was read and discussed. A motion was made by Mrs. Weese to accept the first reading of the ordinance to establish a Building Commission. Motion was seconded by Mr. Lewis, with all members in favor.

An Ordinance of the Common Council of the Town of Beverly Providing for the Purchase of Real Property outside the Corporate Limits of the Municipality from Lloyd A. Heckel and Denise D. Heckel was read. A motion was made by Mr. Moyer to accept the second reading of the ordinance. Motion was seconded by Mrs. Whittaker with all members in favor.

Motion was made to adjourn at 6:47 by Mr. Lewis. Motion seconded by Mr. Moyers. Meeting was adjourned.
