

The regular meeting of the Beverly Town Council was held Monday, March 8, 2021, at 6:30 pm in council chambers of Beverly Town Hall. Members and visitors stood for the Pledge of Allegiance and were led in prayer by Mayor Andy Burns. Mayor Burns called the meeting to order in the presence of recorder Barbara Smith, members Debbie Stalnaker, Robbie Moyer, Matt Lewis, Becky Weese and Katie Whittaker. Visitors included Robin Wilson and Kenny Weese.

With all members having received copies of the minutes, Mr. Moyer made a motion to forego the oral reading of the February 8, 2021 minutes and to accept the minutes as submitted. Motion seconded by Mrs. Stalnaker. Each member also received a report from Recorder Smith showing the order in which names were drawn for the election ballot that were drawn February 22, 2021 in the presence of Clerks Wilson and Dilley at town hall.

2021- 2022 BUDGET APPROVAL WORKSHOP AND MEETING

A workshop is scheduled for Monday, March 22, 2021, at 6:00 to work on the Budget. A meeting will be set for 7:00 to approve the budget.

A tentative meeting is set for Monday, 6:30 pm, March 15, 2021.

STORM WATER PROJECT – SET COMMITTEE MEETING

A meeting is scheduled for the storm water committee on Friday, March 12, 2021 to pick three engineers for the Storm Project, at 10:00 pm.

NOMINATE ELECTION OFFICIALS

Council was provided a poll worker list of six names to work the election polls. No other names were provided. A motion was made by Mr. Moyer to nominate the six names and approve the list provided to council. Motion seconded by Mrs. Weese. All in favor.

Pay for workers was set at \$100.00 for Election Day, \$50.00 for Saturday early voting and \$25.00 for training. A motion was made by Mr. Moyer to accept the rates and seconded by Mrs. Weese. All in favor

EHS PROJECT SAFE GRADUATION

A motion was made by Mr. Lewis to give the EHS Project \$250.00. Motion second by Mrs. Weese with all in favor.

STATE MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT RATE

Although the state mileage reimbursement rate was decreased to 56 cents per mile this year, a motion was made by Mrs. Whittaker to leave it at the old rate of 58 cents per mile paid last year. Motion seconded by Mr. Moyer with all in favor.

CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT

Police Chief Vanscoy reported no part time officers have been picked yet for hiring. He said we still have not received ammunition, but the radar gun has come. He said it's pretty much a waiting game now. We are waiting on the lawyer to do an ordinance for fines. He said we were also waiting on e-citations and other work from Charleston. We need the new budget to incorporate the revenue from the police department. When a citation is written, it will automatically go to Charlestown and the town will be notified how much of the fine needs sent to Charleston. The town has received a couple Municipal Judges who are interested in working here.

Financials were reviewed.

VENDOR INVOICES

A motion was made by Mrs. Weese to pay the town invoices for March 2021 in the amount of \$12, 749.70 (\$5,853.45 Police Dept. Invoices). Seconded by Mr. Moyer with all in favor.

The Mayor did a few updates on the office and pole building. Water and Sewer board minutes were available for council to review, as well as plant operators reporters.

A motion was made by Mr. ^{Lewis} Moyer to adjourn. Second by Mr. Moyer. Meeting adjourned at 7:32 pm.
