Old Business.

R Lanham OIT Hours Approval- R Lanham OIT hours for June were approved and signed off by Kenny Weese and David Simmons.

New Business.

Rossi Well on Georgetown- Before any decisions can be made there are several factors that we need to look into. The cost to build the pump house, the price of the pumps, the cost of electricity to run the pumps, the price of chemicals to treat the water, the cost to run the water line. Will we be able to get funding to cover some of the costs? We also need to have something in writing regarding the cost that we will pay for the water, the type of lease, how many years do we want the lease to last, if we will have an easement to the piece of property where the pump house will be located in case we need to work on the pump house. Once the Board gets all the information that is needed they will need to get together and discuss if this will be feasible for the town.

Air Compressor- Kenny Weese made the motion to take the air compressor that is at the Sewer Plant and move it to the Water Plant and put in the old chlorine room. Purchase a new compressor to put in the pole building at the Sewer Plant. David Simmons seconded; motion carried.AIF

Grants- Once the grant for the jetter system is completed all of our grant materials will be paid for.

Hiring Office Assistant- This position will be secretary to the Police Chief and at times will help the Utilities Clerk and Town Clerk when needed. David Simmons made the motion to pay 1/4 of the wages. Kenny Weese seconded; AIF

Cory Weese to Part Time Water Plant Operator- Cory accepted a new job with Rural Water and asked If he could work part time as a plant operator and work as needed. David Simmons made the motion to move Cory to part time plant operator. Kenny Weese seconded; motion carried. AIF

Repair Hydrant on Main Street- David Simmons made the motion to repair the hydrant. Kenny Weese seconded; motion carried.AIF
